# Subject: Invitation for enrollment in the Green Button Qualification Programme (GBQP) to develop factory in accordance with MADE IN GREEN by OEKO-TEX.

Dear Honorable Members,

You all are aware that BGMEA and GIZ have been working together to improve compliance standards in the readymade garment (RMG) and textile factories in Bangladesh since 2007 under different German Bangladesh bilateral development cooperation projects.

Currently, a new German Bangladesh bilateral project named "Programme for Sustainability in the Textile and Leather Sector (STILE)" is going to implement Green Button Qualification Programme (GBQP) in 250 export-oriented RMG and textile factories in Bangladesh with an objective to improve compliance with social and environmental standards to obtain a relevant international credible certification label (e.g. MADE IN GREEN by OEKO-TEX and GOTS) in accordance with the Green Button requirements under the close cooperation of two industry associations - Bangladesh Garment Manufacturers and Exporters Association (BGMEA), Bangladesh Knitwear Manufacturers and Exporters Association (BKMEA) and other relevant stakeholders (retailers, brands, etc.). Out of 250 factories, **100 factories** will be developed to obtain **MADE IN GREEN by OEKO-TEX certification** and 150 for GOTS certification.

MADE IN GREEN by OEKO-TEX requires the combination of the STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX and STeP by OEKO-TEX certification in accordance with OEKO-TEX guidelines.

Under GBQP - MADE IN GREEN by OEKO-TEX, the project will provide necessary advisory and backstopping support to 100 eligible factories (which have valid certification on STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX) to obtain **STEP by OEKO-TEX** certification for fulfilling the requirements of MADE IN GREEN by OEKO-TEX.

The German Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development (BMZ) launched the Grüner Knopf (hereafter: Green Button) initiative in September 2019. It certifies socially and environmentally manufactured textiles sold by responsible companies. The BMZ also launched the official Green Button website, which is available in German at http://www.gruener-knopf.de/.

The overall objective of this cooperation is to establish sustainable compliance at factory level by capacity development of the factory compliance officials providing necessary training and advisory services on social and environmental standards in relation to MADE IN GREEN by OEKO-TEX as well as Green Button requirements. Advisory services have to be provided on:

- Identifying compliance gaps of the participating factories in accordance with MADE IN GREEN by OEKO-TEX and Green Button requirements.
- Preparing corrective action plans based on identified compliance gaps and follow-up implementation of corrective action plans.

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- Advisory and backstopping support to the factories by using on-site factory visits and virtual platform and providing them necessary on the job advisory support in enhancing capacity and making factories well-equipped to qualify for the STeP by OEKO-TEX certification audit by the approved third-party audit companies to obtain a relevant and credible certification in accordance with STeP by OEKO-TEX standards.

In order to participate in the project a factory should

- be member of BGMEA
- have valid Trade License, Factory License
- have valid Fire License
- have valid Environmental Clearance Certificate (if applicable)
- have approved building plan and/or design from RAJUK or relevant local authority
- be a supplier directly to a buyer or buying house or at least to a factory who directly exports to the buyers
- have valid certification on STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX
- not have any approved valid green button certification label (Blauer Engel, FAIRTRADE TEXTILE PRODUCTION, NATURTEXTIL IVN certified BEST) in accordance with social and ecological standards or *STeP by OEKO-TEX* certification.
- have sincere interest and commitment towards improvement of compliance with social and environmental standards.

As, only 100 factories will get an opportunity to participate in the Green Button Qualification Programme (GBQP) - MADE IN GREEN by OEKO-TEX (e.g. *STeP by OEKO-TEX*), so it is requested to send an application by the interested factories along with information of annex-1 in the company's letter head pad to BGMEA office addressing Mr. Mohammad Monower Hossain, Joint Secretary (Sustainability), BGMEA, Cell no: +8801674822026), by e-mail (monower@bgmea.com.bd) with a CC to Md. The factory does not have a valid GOTS certification will get preference to enroll in this programme. Please feel free to contact with Mr. Md.
