

We hereby confirm our participation at **Apparel & Textile Exhibition Malaysia 2026** and we confirm our acceptance of the Rules & Regulations printed overleaf which form part of this contract. The execution of this application contract and its receipt by **Kaizer Exhibitions & Conferences Sdn Bhd** is deemed conclusive evidence of the applicants' agreement to pay the full fees dues.

EXHIBITION RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Organizer and manager - The Exhibition is organised by the Organizer and its management is undertaken by the Manager on the Organizer's behalf.
2. License -After the payment of the full contract price the Exhibitor will have a conditional and revocable license to participate in Exhibition. The Manager may allocate the exhibit space ("Stand/s") which the Exhibitor is to occupy. This agreement is not and shall not be deemed to be a lease or an agreement for lease.
3. Allocation - Stand/will be allocated at the Manager's full discretion. The Manager may change the floor plan or exhibit of display of Exhibitor ("the Exhibit"). The Manager's determination with respect to allocation of the Stand/s will be binding on the Exhibitor. The full contract price is payable even if the Exhibitor eventually does not utilize the whole Stand where practicable Stand/will be allocated according to the Exhibitors sequence of choices. If not Stand is available for the Exhibitor then the sole obligation of the Organizer and the Manager is to refund to the Exhibitor such amount of the money received by the Organizer of the Manager, from the Exhibitor and the Organizer and the Manager shall have no other liability whatsoever.
4. Exhibitor - Exhibits will be limited to materials, products or services of specific interest to registrants of the Exhibition. The Manager reserves the right to determine the eligibility of any material, product or service for display or advertisement. The Manager may limit the number of principals that can be represented by the Exhibitor in a single Stand. The decision of the Manager with regard to whether any use or proposed use of the Stand/s permitted under this Agreement shall be final. The Exhibitor shall not assign or underlet the stand or any part there-of without the prior consent of the organizer and the manager.
5. Warranty - The Exhibitor represents warrants and undertakes that it is entering into this Agreement as principal and not as agent or nominee of any third party and the exhibits do not infringe or are likely any patent, trade mark, copyright and other intellectual property right of any party and it agrees that in the event of any breach of the representations, warranties and undertakings herein contained this Agreement and the license herein granted may be terminated by the Manager (without the Manager being liable for any damages or claims whatsoever and without prejudice to the Manager's other rights and remedies) and the Exhibitor shall indemnify the Organizer and the Manager against any and all costs, claims, demands, losses, liabilities, charges, actions and expenses.
6. Admission - Exhibits will be open to all exhibition registrants. A nominal registration fee may be charged by the Manager. The Manager reserves the right to regulate admission to any person.
7. Standfitting services - The Exhibitor shall bear the cost of all standfitting works for exhibits under the Shell Scheme, standfitting works can only be carried out by the Official Standfitting Contractor. For other exhibits, standfitting works can be carried out by the Official Standfitting Contractors or by a contractor appointed by the Exhibitor provided that such contractor shall have been approved by the Manager and shall have provide the Manager with a security deposit (or a banker's guarantee in lieu thereof) in an amount acceptable to the Manager. The Exhibitor shall bear the cost of all such standfitting works, whether relating to the Shell Scheme or otherwise.
8. Electrical works and electricity supply - Lighting, lighting mains, power plugs, power mains and motors are available as provided in the Exhibitor Manual. Where the Exhibitor requires any electrical work in connection with its Exhibit, such work shall only be carried out by the Official Electrical Contractor appointed by the Manager, as described in the Exhibitor Manual. The Exhibitor shall bear the cost at all such electrical work and for all electricity consumed from the allocated exhibit space and shall forthwith upon The Managers written request pay to the Manager or as directed by the Manager an amount sufficient in the view of the Manager to cover and pay for such costs.
9. Photography - All photographic rights are reserved to the Manager. Photography during the Exhibition shall only be carried out by the Official Photographers appointed by the Manager at charges set out in the Exhibitor Manual.
10. Advertising matter - The Manager may prohibit the distribution at any advertising material for any reason whatsoever
11. Cancellation - Except as otherwise expressly provided herein, no refund will be made of any money paid to the Organizer or the Manager under any circumstances whatsoever including in the event of the Exhibitor deciding not to participate in the Exhibition. The Manager may retain all amounts then paid by the Exhibitor and also to recover all amounts due under this Agreement.
12. Liability and risks - The Exhibitor shall insure, indemnify fully and effectively and hold the Organizer, the Manager and their respective shareholders, the lessors of the premises where the Exhibition is held and all government, statutory and regulatory bodies and agencies of the country where the Exhibition is held and their respective directors, officers, agents and servants harmless against any and all costs, claims, demands, losses, liabilities, charges, actions and "expenses which any of them may be subject to or may incur or which may be made, claimed or instituted against them or any of them as a result of any act, breach of any of the terms of this Agreement, omission conduct, failure of the Exhibitor or its directors, officers, agents, servants, invitees or independent contractors. The Exhibitor's aforesaid indemnify shall extend to all losses or injuries caused to any persons or property howsoever caused by the Exhibitor or its Exhibits or personnel or otherwise arising while the said persons are upon or examining, observing of passing the Exhibit or Stencils occupied by the Exhibitor or by the demonstration of otherwise in connection with the Exhibit. The liability or risks of loss or damage to the Exhibitor's employees or agents or the Exhibits shall be the responsibility of the Exhibitor. Exhibits shall be placed at the Exhibitors own risks and the Organizer, the Manager their respective directors, officers and agents shall not be held responsible for any theft, damage loss or destruction of the Exhibits. Under no circumstances will the Organizer, the Manager any government statutory or regulatory body or agency of their respective directors, officers and agents make good of accept responsibility or be liable howsoever in respect of any damage theft, loss or destruction of the Exhibits or any property, goods or articles or things whatsoever placed, deposited, brought into or left upon the Exhibition premises by the Exhibitor.
13. Insurance policy - The Exhibitor shall take out and maintain from approved insurance companies an insurance policy in connection with the Exhibition in such form and for such amount as may be required by the Manager from time to time. The Exhibitor shall punctually pay all premiums payable on such insurance policy. If the Exhibitor fails to comply with the provisions herein the Manager may effect such insurance and pay the insurance premiums and all moneys so expended shall on demand be repaid to the Manager by the Exhibitor. The Exhibitor shall not do or permit of suffer to be done anything whereby any insurance policy taken out by the Organizer or Manager (if any) may be rendered void or voidable or whereby the rate of premium thereon may be increased. The Exhibitor shall make good all damage suffered by the Organizer and shall repay to the Organizer all sums paid by way of increased premiums and all expenses incurred by the Organizer in or about the renewal at such policy or policies rendered necessary by a breach or non-observance of this Clause without prejudice to any other rights of the Organizer. The Exhibitor shall procure the insurance company or companies which issued the insurance policy to waive their rights of subrogation against such person as The Manager require.
14. Safety, fire, health and other law - All fire, safety, health and other laws, rules and regulations imposed by the Manager or local authorities and agencies or the lessor of the Exhibition premises must be strictly observed by the Exhibitor.
15. Prohibited exhibits - No live military equipment, including munitions, aircraft armament, small arms ammunition and explosives weapon systems, tactical missiles, rockets, etc. shall be brought onto the Exhibition premises. Other kinds of exhibits may be prohibited by the Manager. The Exhibitor is solely responsible for ensuring that all government and other regulatory approval required for the Exhibits and its participation in the Exhibition shall have been obtained prior to the date of the Exhibition.
16. Losses - The Organizer and the Manager shall not be responsible for damage to the Exhibitor's property howsoever caused or lost shipments either coming in or going out, or for moving costs. The Exhibitor is responsible in all cases for the full contract price payable under this Agreement.
17. Termination
(a) If the Exhibition premises shall become, in the sole discretion of the Manager, unfit for occupancy, or if the holding of The Exhibition or the performance of the Organizer or the Manager of any of the provisions of this Agreement are interfered with by virtue of any cause. This Agreement and/or The Exhibitor (or any part thereof) may forthwith be terminated or cancelled by the Manager without the Organizer or the Manager being liable in damages or otherwise to the Exhibitor. The Organizer and the Manager shall also not be responsible for delays, damages, loss, increased costs, or other unfavourable conditions arising by virtue of any cause not within the control of the Organizer or the Manager. Upon the termination or cancellation as aforesaid the Organizer shall not be liable to the Exhibitor other for a prorated refund of the contract price free paid by the Exhibitor on the basis of the number of exhibit days remaining. For purposes hereof, the phrase cause not within the control of the Organizer of the Manager shall include fire casualty, flood epidemic, earthquake, explosion or accident, blockade embargo, inclement weather governmental restraints, restraints or orders of civil defence or military authorities act of public enemy riot or Civil disturbance, strike, lockout, boycott or other labour, dispute or disturbance inability to secure sufficient labour, technical or other personnel absence of premises required for The Exhibition, failure impairment or lack adequate transportation facilities inability to obtain or condemnation requisition or commandeering necessary supplies or equipment, local state or other law ordinance, rule order decree or regulation whether legislative, executive or judicial and whether constitutional or unconstitutional, or Act of God. (b) This agreement may be terminated by the Manager forthwith if in the Manager's opinion when the Exhibitor does not or may be unable to perform or comply will any of its obligation.
18. Right to reject or eject - The Manager may reject, eject or prohibit the Exhibition in whole or in part, or the Exhibitor or its representatives with or without giving cause. If cause is not given, the maximum liability of the Organizer or the Manager (if any) shall not exceed the return to the Exhibitor of the pro-rata amount of The contract price paid by the Exhibitor based on the number of days of the Exhibition remaining at the time of election if an exhibit or exhibitor is ejected for violation of any provisions of this Agreement or for any other stated reason, no refund of any portion of the contract price shall be made.
19. Right of possession - The Exhibitor hereby grants to the Organizer the right for purposes of ensuring the due performance by The Exhibitor of its obligations under this Agreement to possession of all property of the Exhibitor, including the Exhibits, on the Exhibitor premises. Such right to possession shall be superior to that of any person. All such property shall be deemed to be pledged to the Organizer as security for the performance by the Exhibitor of its obligations under this Agreement and the Organizer may remove sell or otherwise dispose of all of the same upon such terms and conditions as it deems fit. If such property is not removed from the Exhibition premises by the end of The removal period specified in The Exhibitor Manual then the Organizer shall be at liberty to remove, sell or otherwise dispose of such property, and the net proceeds applied by the Manager for such purpose as it deems appropriate The Exhibitor shall indemnify The Organizer against all costs and expenses incurred in connection with such removal, safe or disposal and any claim by a third party to any such property so, sold or disposed of.
20. Sub-licensing - This licence to participate in the Exhibition is personal to the Exhibitor is non-transferable and no licensing or sub-licensing may be granted by the Exhibitor to any other party. The Exhibitor shall not assign or sublet the Stand or any part thereof. The Organizer and/or the Manager may assign or transfer -its rights and/or obligations. The Exhibitor may not assign or transfer any of its rights or obligations under this Agreement.
21. Manager as agent - All rights powers and discretions exercised by the Manager, or consent or agreement given or made by the Manager shall be deemed to be carried out as agent on behalf of the Organizer the Manager shall have no responsibility or liability whatsoever to the Exhibitor or any other party.
22. Liability limitation - The liability of the Organizer (if any) shall under no circumstances (whether arising from breach of contract tort or otherwise) exceed the amount of the total contract price paid by the Exhibitor for the herein granted. The person or persons appointed by the Manager to undertake any official tasks including to the Official Standfitting Contractor and the Official Electrical Contractor are independent contractors and are not agents of the Organizer or the Manager.
23. Governing law and jurisdiction - This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the country of incorporation of the Organizer, the exhibitor hereby irrevocably and unconditionally submits to the non-exclusive jurisdiction of the Courts of the country of incorporation of the Organizer for all purpose in relation to this Agreement and waives any objections on the ground of venue forum non conveniencie or on similar grounds.
24. Revocation - Upon termination at this Agreement the license granted is revoked and thereupon the Exhibitor shall immediately leave the Exhibition premises and remove all its Exhibits.
25. Stamp and other duties - The Exhibitor shall pay all and any stamp and other taxes or duties, including any interest and penalties, payable on or in connection with this Agreement.
26. Exhibitor Manual and floor plan - Further rules and regulations pertaining to the Exhibition can be found in the Exhibitor Manual and other documents supplied by the Manager from time to time. The Manager may at any time and from time to time make further rules and regulations (having immediate effect) in relation to any aspect of the Exhibition such rules and regulations shall be deemed to form part of this Agreement, and shall be binding on the Exhibitor. The Manager may time to time be entitled to change the exhibit floor plan.
27. Partial Invalidity - The invalidity or unenforceability of any provision of this Agreement shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision.
28. Remedies and Implied Waivers - No failure or delay on the part the Manager to exercise, any right or remedy under this Agreement will operate as a waiver thereof nor will any single or particle exercise of any right to remedy preclude any other or further exercise thereof or the exercise any other right or remedy. The right and remedies provided are cumulative and not exclusive of any rights or remedies provided by law.
29. Set-off Clause - The Organizer and/or the Manager may deduct from or set-off against any money due from the Organizer or the Manager to the Exhibitor any sum which the Exhibitor is liable to pay to the Organizer or the Manager.
30. Compliance Clause - The Exhibitor shall, upon the Manager's written request forthwith take all necessary action and/or refrain from any further action which is in the Manager's view, necessary to comply with any of its obligations and forthwith provide any necessary information or document to evidence such compliance.
31. Amendment Clause - This Agreement shall be amended only in the form prescribed by the Manager for such purposes from time to time.
32. Assignment Clause - The Organizer and/or the Manager may without the consent or approval of the Exhibitor assign or transfer its rights and/or obligations under this Agreement. The Exhibitor may not assign or transfer any of its rights or obligations under this Agreement.

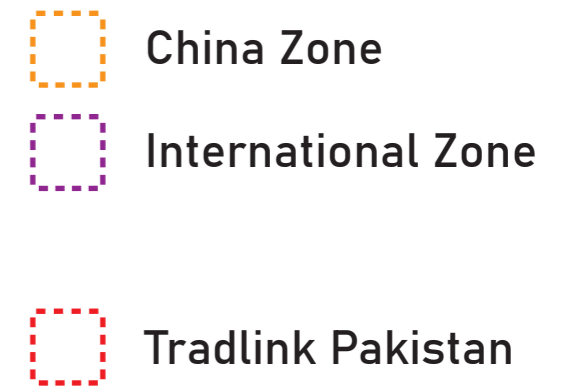
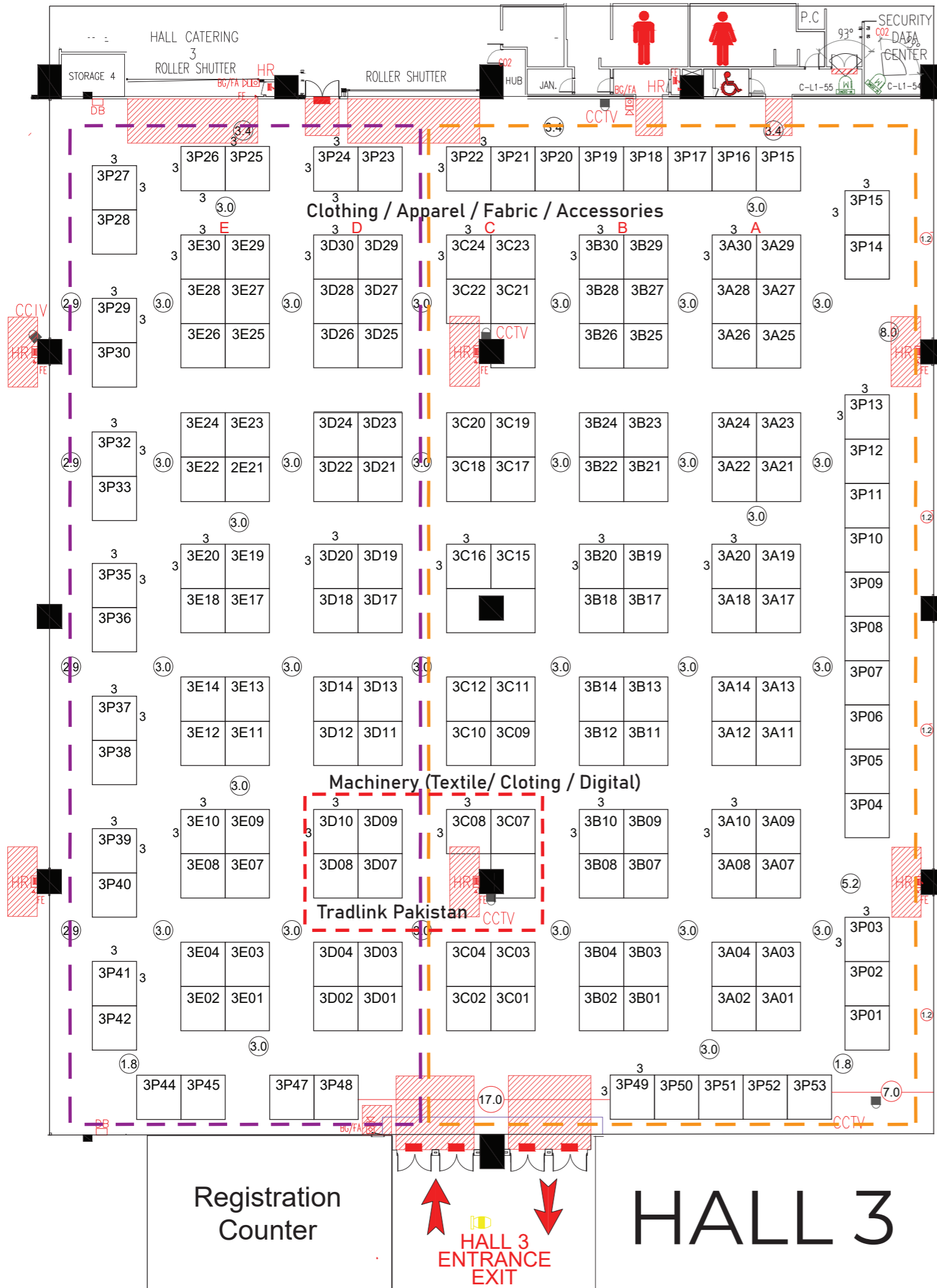
