

Additionally, it is expected to attract approximately 40000 buyers from both India and abroad. This presents an excellent opportunity for BGMEA member factories to attend the fair and connect with potential buyers and source desired products.

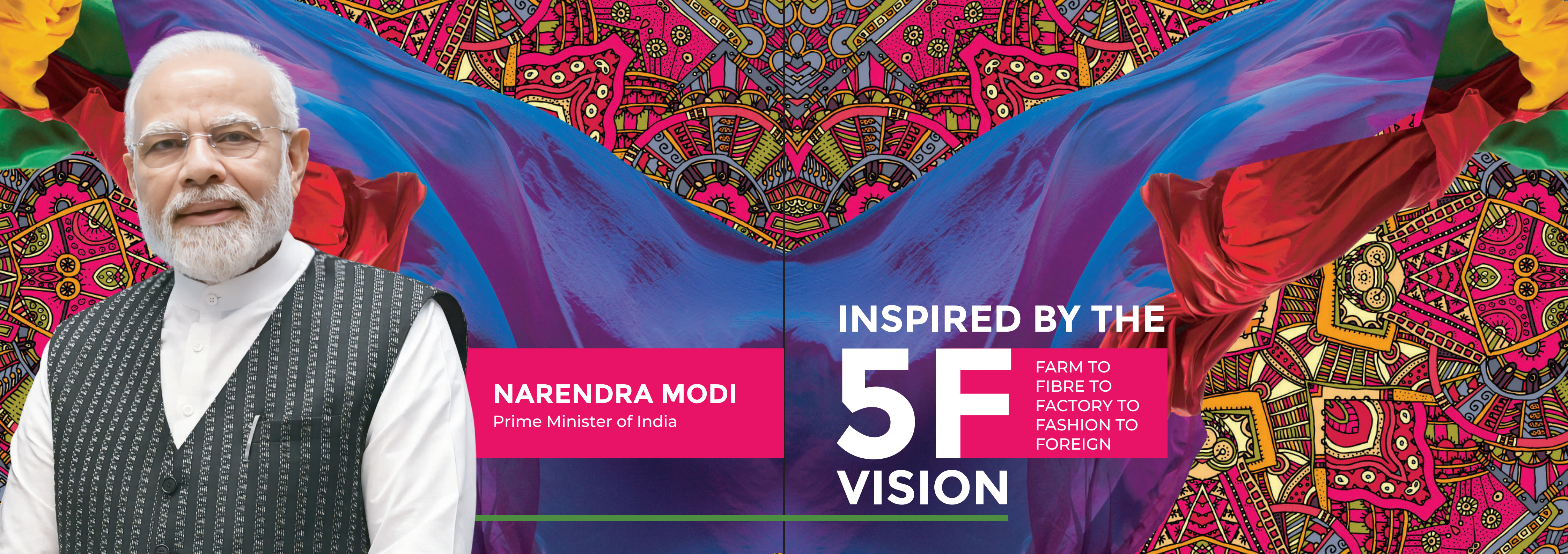

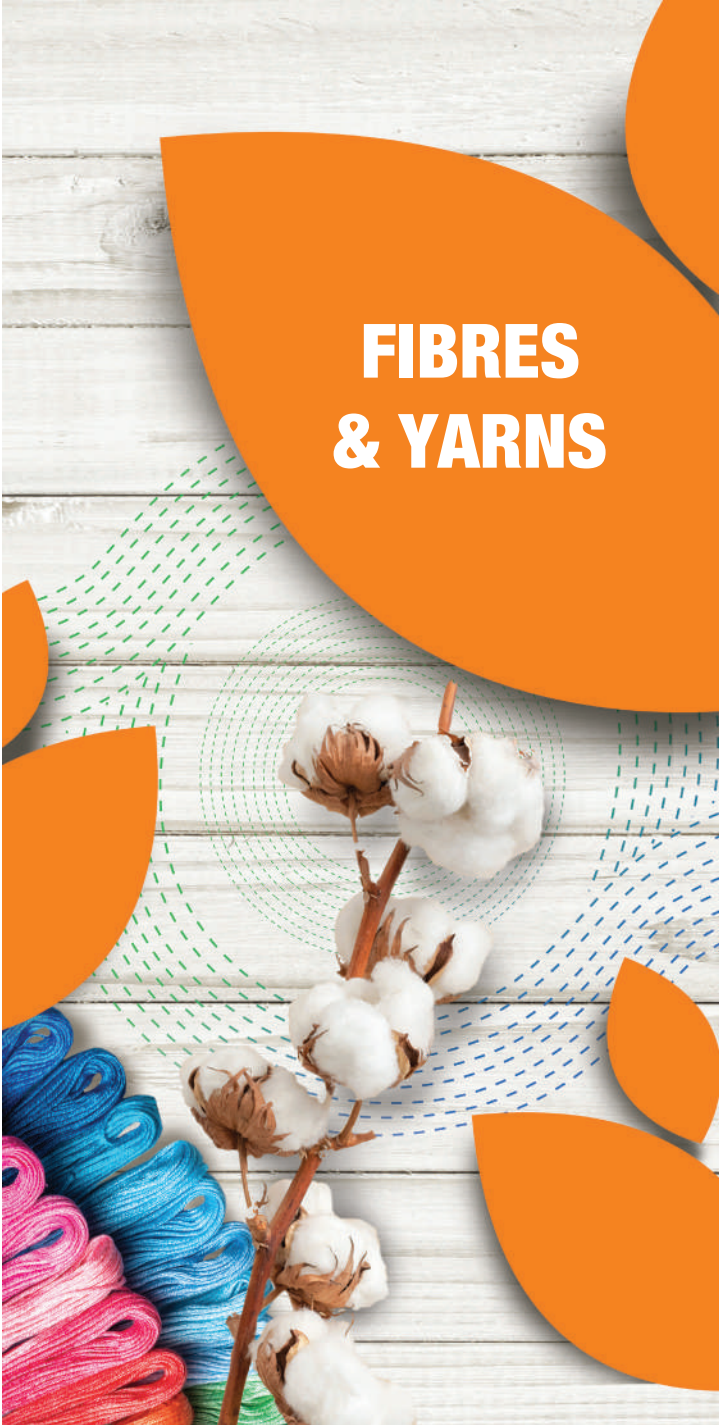
